Conditions Governing the Transportation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances

These conditions are issued subject to provisions of the Environmental Management Act No. 12 of 2011, the general provisions of Part V of the Environmental Management (Licensing) Regulations, Statutory Instrument No. 112 of 2013 and the following specific conditions:

1. These conditions shall be valid for the **Transportation of Pesticides and Toxic substances** only using a vehicle of registration numbers as set out in the **annex attached hereto** (the vehicle or conveyance).

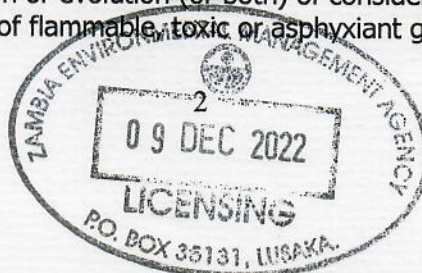

2. Details of the labelling of Pesticides and Toxic Substances signs that shall be used on Warning Panels and compartment labels during transportation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances are the ones set out in Tenth and Eleventh Schedules of the Environmental Management (Licensing) Regulations, Statutory Instrument No. 112 of 2013.
3. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited shall** ensure that all hazard warnings are displayed, not obstructed, and shall be kept clean at all times.
4. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited shall** ensure that the transport emergency card relating to the Pesticide(s) or Toxic Substance(s) is in the vehicle or conveyance.
5. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited shall** use hazard warning symbols on the vehicle or conveyance which comply with the standards for the classification and labelling of chemicals and the standards on the transportation of dangerous goods prescribed under the Standards Act.
6. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited** should always ensure that any vehicle or conveyance availed for transportation of Pesticide(s) or Toxic Substance(s) has certificate of fitness for the road and also for goods.





- The driver of Pesticide(s) or Toxic Substance(s) shall follow the route as advised by the transporter or operator.
8. The vehicle or conveyance shall not be left unattended at any time.
 9. During transportation of the Pesticides and Toxic Substances **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited shall** ensure that the products are **properly packed** and **arranged** such that possible chances of cross mixing or **spillage /leakage** of chemicals will not occur.
 10. All emergencies and accidents should be reported to the Zambia Environmental Management Agency (ZEMA) and other relevant authorities **immediately**.
 11. Packaging shall not incorporate materials that can react dangerously with its contents, form hazardous compounds or lead to softening, weakening or failure of the container or its closure.
 12. The vehicle or conveyance in use for transportation of the Pesticides and Toxic Substances must be **solely** used for this purpose **alone** not any other.
 13. The vehicle or conveyance used in the transportation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances must have a canopy or a tent to cover on top to avoid particulates of the chemicals mixing with air thus posing a danger to the general public and the environment.
 14. The driver shall carry First Aid equipment and shall have the necessary basic training in handling Pesticides or Toxic Substances.
 15. The driver of Pesticides and Toxic Substances shall carry a Transport Emergency Card.
 16. The driver of Pesticides and Toxic Substances shall have **a licence or qualification to transport dangerous goods**.
 17. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited** shall send **bi-annual reports** related to transportation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances to ZEMA without fail on or **before July 15 and January 15** for each year of the validity period for the licence in the attached format. In addition to the hard copies, bi-annual reports shall be submitted in authenticated electronic format to the following email- returns@zema.org.zm.
 18. ZEMA Inspectors **shall have the right to inspect the transport/conveyance at any reasonable time**.
 19. Pesticides and Toxic Substances shall not be packed in the same outer packaging as another type of Toxic Substances or Non- Toxic Substances if they react dangerously with one another and give rise to any (or a combination) of the following:
 - i. The combustion or evolution (or both) of considerable heat;
 - ii. The evolution of flammable, toxic or asphyxiant gases;





- iii. The formation of corrosive substances; and
 - iv. The formation of unstable substances.
20. Pesticides and Toxic Substance must not be transported using public service vehicles.
21. The licence is valid for a period of **three years** from the **25th** day of **November, 2022** to the **24th** day of **November, 2025** and may be renewed for like period if the company complies with the above conditions.
22. **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited shall** not transfer the licence to a third party without the prior approval by ZEMA.
23. An application for **renewal and/or transfer** shall be made at least six months before the expiry of the licence.
24. ZEMA may **revoke and/or suspend** this licence at any time and **without notice** in the event that **Simba Supply Chain Solutions Limited fails** to comply with these conditions.
